Approval of Minutes

Regular Meeting, March 9, 2026: A motion was offered by Kathy Moreau and seconded by Eddie Godwin to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held March 9, 2026. Motion carried.

Financial Statements

A. Grimmett provided a review of the March financial statements. Sales tax revenue posted for the month of March was up 66.56% compared to March 2025 and is up year to date. The monthly financial statement and budget analysis was received and filed on a motion by Pete Olivier and Chad Briscoe. Motion carried.

Committee Reports, Tuesday, March 24, 2026:

Recycling: Pete Olivier, Chairman

Recommendation: To approve the Cardboard Recycling Sales Agreement with Ventura Foods. A motion was offered by Eddie Godwin and seconded by Kathy Moreau to approve the committee recommendation. Motion carried.

Landfill: Michael Harden, Chairman

Chairman Harden gave a report on items discussed during the Landfill Committee meeting. No recommendations were offered for consideration.

Finance: Jodie Powell, Chairperson

Recommendation: To authorize the piggyback purchase of limestone aggregate as awarded through St. Landry Parish Government bid. A motion was offered by Chad Briscoe and seconded by Eddie Godwin to approve the committee recommendation. Motion carried.

Administrative: Jerry Domengeaux, Chairman

Recommendation: To authorize publication of the bulky waste guidelines in the Eunice News for 90 days. A motion was offered by Kathy Moreau and seconded by Jodie Powell to approve the committee recommendation. Motion carried.

Tamea Hollier with Dupre Carrier Godchaux Ins. Agency, and James Wallace and Kevin Simoneaux with Forth Insurance presented proposals for property and casualty insurance.

A motion was offered by Jerry Domengeaux and Kathy Moreau to accept the proposal from Forth Insurance in the amount of \$282,642.87 for Property and Casualty Insurance. Motion carried.

A motion was offered by Jerry Domengeaux and seconded by Kathy Moreau to authorize the purchase of two 6” fast flow hydraulic submersible pumps and one 4 x 6 steel floating platform from Consolidated Pumps & Equipment, LLC, at a total cost of \$35,500.00 plus freight. Motion carried.

A motion was offered by Kathy Moreau and seconded by Jodie Powell to authorize the repair of 13 six-yard recycling containers and 11 eight-yard recycling containers by Circle H Welding at a total cost of \$26,900.00. Motion carried.

A motion was offered by Jodie Powell and seconded by Michael Harden to approve the 1st Quarter 2026 budget amendments. Motion carried.

Inspector’s Report – John Guidroz

The March 2026 Inspector’s Report was presented. 367 permits were issued for 719 loads and carts and bags were provided for three special events. Updates on litter abatement hours and crew details and bulky waste hauled were provided by the inspector.

Director’s Report – Richard LeBouef

The Director gave updates on the litter abatement crews, a meeting with St. Landry Parish 911 Emergency about the new GIS/Geographic Information System, and his re-appointment for a 3-year term to the LDEQ Board of Certification and Training for Solid Waste Operators.
