**Approval of Minutes**

Regular Meeting, December 8, 2025: A motion was offered by Eddie Godwin and seconded by Jerry Domengeaux to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held December 8, 2025. Motion carried.

**Financial Statements**

Amanda Grimmatt provided a review of the December financial statements. Sales tax revenue posted for the month of December was down 0.36% compared to December 2024 and is down year to date. The monthly financial statement and budget analysis was received and filed on a motion by Eddie Godwin and Stephen Quebedeaux. Motion carried.

A motion was offered by Jerry Domengeaux and seconded by Pete Olivier to approve the proposed annual contract with Acadiana Construction & Environmental, LLC as presented for CNG inspection and maintenance. Motion carried.

A motion was offered by Eddie Godwin and seconded by Jerry Domengeaux to approve the proposed annual contract with Fourrier & de Abreu Engineers, LLC as presented for environmental monitoring and compliance services. Motion carried.

A motion was offered by Jodie Powell and seconded by Stephen Quebedeaux to reclassify M. Levier from Warehouse/Driver at Recycling to Groundskeeper at Landfill and set pay at Level 17 on Groundskeeper pay scale effective on the January 21, 2026, payroll. Motion carried.

A motion was offered by Chad Briscoe and seconded by Jodie Powell to approve the brokering of recyclable material. Motion carried.

A motion was offered by Jerry Domengeaux and seconded by Pete Olivier to adjourn to Executive Session to discuss demand from Norman Gobert for Administrative Settlement and Resolution. A voice/roll call vote was taken and carried unanimously.

A motion was offered by Eddie Godwin and seconded by Michael Harden to return to Regular Session. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was offered by Chad Briscoe and seconded by Stephen Quebedeaux to decline the demand from Norman Gobert for Administrative Settlement and Resolution. Motion carried unanimously.

**Inspector's Report** – John Guidroz

The December 2025 Inspector's Report was presented. 336 permits were issued for 618 loads and there were no container requests or special events. Litter abatement hours and crew details, bulky waste hauled by Solid Waste, Litter Abatement, and Morgan and Morgan, and Bayou State Waste updates were provided by the inspector. No issues were reported by Bayou State Waste or Morgan and Morgan.

Opelousas Mayor Julius Alsandor addressed the commission the thank them for the work they do for the City of Opelousas and stated he will be working with the city on reducing litter and issuing citations if needed.
