Approval of Minutes

Regular Meeting, February 9, 2026: A motion was offered by Kathy Moreau and seconded by Eddie Godwin to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held February 9, 2026. Motion carried.

Financial Statements

A. Grimmitt provided a review of the February financial statements. Sales tax revenue posted for the month of February was down 52.26% compared to February 2025 and is down year to date. It was noted that three February sales tax deposits were pending on March 2, 2026, and not included. The monthly financial statement and budget analysis was received and filed on a motion by Kathy Moreau and Pete Olivier. Motion carried.

Landfill: Michael Harden, Chairman

Recommendation: To authorize Aucoin & Associates to review the bids for the construction of Cells 18 & 19 and present a recommendation at the March 9, 2026, regular meeting. A motion was offered by Jerry Domengeaux and seconded by Eddie Godwin to approve the committee recommendation. Motion carried.

David Hidalgo with Aucoin & Associates stated that he reviewed the bids submitted on February 26, 2026, and recommends a contract for the construction of Cells 18 & 19 be awarded to Precision Construction, LLC in the amount of \$1,195,811.47.

Recommendation: To approve the quote by Ritter Forest Products and authorize the purchase of 42 landfill construction mats at a cost of \$25,200.00. A motion was offered by Jerry Domengeaux and seconded by Eddie Godwin to approve the committee recommendation. Motion carried.

Recommendation: To select the Eunice News as the legal journal for the St. Landry Parish Solid Waste Disposal District for a 12-month period ending March 2027. A motion was offered by Kathy Moreau and seconded by Eddie Godwin to approve the committee recommendation. Motion carried.

A motion was offered by Pete Olivier and seconded by Kathy Moreau to hold a household hazardous waste day event on Saturday, November 7, 2026. Motion carried.

Recycling: Pete Olivier, Chairman

Chairman Olivier gave a report on items discussed during the Recycling Committee meeting. No recommendations were offered for consideration.

A motion was offered by Kathy Moreau and seconded by Jodie Powell to approve the cost estimate by Aucoin & Associates for professional engineering, design, and construction phase services in connection with construction of Cells 8 & 19. Motion carried.

A motion was offered by Kathy Moreau and seconded by Stephen Quebedeaux to approve the 4th Quarter 2025 investment report. Motion carried.

A motion was offered by Jodie Powell and seconded by Michael Harden to approve the updated job description for Mechanic and move J.B. from Level 10 to Level 14 on the Mechanic pay scale effective on the March 17, 2026, payroll. Motion carried.

A motion was offered by Kathy Moreau and seconded by Jerry Domengeaux to change the date for committee meetings to Tuesday, March 24, 2026, due to a conflict with the Louisiana Solid Waste Association (LSWA) conference. Motion carried.

A motion was offered by Michael Harden and seconded by Jerry Domengeaux to adjourn to Executive Session to discuss the Norman Gobert claim. A voice vote was taken, and motion carried.

A motion was offered by Kathy Moreau and seconded by Eddie Godwin to return to Regular Session. Motion carried.

Inspector's Report – John Guidroz

The February 2026 Inspector's Report was presented. 292 permits were issued for 661 loads and carts and bags were provided for two special events. Litter abatement hours and crew details, bulky waste hauled by Solid Waste, Litter Abatement and Morgan and Morgan, and Bayou State Waste updates were provided by the inspector.

Director's Report – Richard LeBouef

The Director's gave a report on the litter abatement crews, the Solid Waste Road bridge, a meeting with St. Landry Parish 911 Emergency Geographic Information System, and the EPA regulations related to our CNG and RINs.
